The 1986 NASFAA Conference is being held in Dallas, Texas July 20-23, 1986 at the Registry Hotel in Dallas. NASFAA has a proud tradition of offering conference members a program that enhances professional growth and the 1986 conference will be no different.

The registration fees are reasonable. The pre-registration fee will be \$175.00. The on site registration fee will be \$200.00. There will be no multiple registrant fee this year. The pre-conference registration deadline will be July 3, 1986. The Registry Hotel room rate for a single or double will be \$79.00. The Marriott, which is the overflow hotel, will be \$78.00 for a single or double. It is a good idea to make your hotel reservations at the Registry early. The hotel will begin to accept room reservations after the New Year. The phone number is 214-248-4300. You should tell the hotel you are making reservations for the NASFAA Conference on July 20-23 so you will get the conference room rate. A hotel reservation card will be included with the pre-conference registration material.
